Re School Presentations – École Clearbrook Elementary and Bakerview Centre for Learning

This report is presented to the Board for information.

BACKGROUND:

To deepen the understanding and connection between the Board's activities and the district's core mission of preparing students for a lifetime of success, *School Presentations* will serve as a standard feature at Public Board Meetings and are scheduled for the next two years. This strategic initiative provides a dynamic and interactive forum for our staff and students to showcase innovative work happening in our schools, highlighting how efforts contribute to student achievement and align with operational plans.

The following schools will be present at the March 2025 Public Board Meeting:

École Clearbrook Elementary: This year, École Clearbrook Elementary introduced an optional Grade 5 Punjabi Language class for the first time. Principal Erica Hopkins will provide an update on the program's implementation and introduce the team involved. Punjabi Language Teacher Amardeep Bhullar will give a brief overview of the class structure and learning activities. Some Grade 5 students will then demonstrate some of the vocabulary they have been practicing, offering the Board an opportunity to participate in a brief interactive exercise.

Bakerview Centre for Learning: Principal Jacqui Hall will provide a brief update on this year's Student Voice Survey, highlighting key insights from students. Students and their teacher will share their experiences with the school's Grade 9 Pod, discussing its impact on transitions from both middle and secondary school. Another student will speak about their journey to Bakerview and how one of the school's career programs has supported their future goals.
